


Notes: Homepage - Logged Out

- Logo lives in the header and is sticky with the main
- Main navigation is sticky on scroll and expands when the user clicks on an item that has sub-pages.

- The hero area will be a masonry grid featuring phot and CTAs.
- Intro image or icon with copy, Learn more button to user to the Sign Up page.
- Three featured pages. On click, the user is taken to that page.






Notes: Join the Community

- A calendar and a Google map that display mappable events/trainings in the MA area. When user selects a date on the calendar, the map will dynamically change to reflect events for that date. The calendar will default to the current day.
- User can click on a marker within the map to see the event name and a brief description. Clicking on the Read More link will bring them to the detail page for that event.
- News and Events from the map are also listed below
 A button to view all will link to the landing page for
- News or Event detail with the category name, date, and clickable headline. Clicking on the headline brings the user to that detail page. Clicking "4 Add to toolkit" will automatically add the content to the user's toolkit and then say "Added! View Now >" in place of the link.











Notes: Build Your Toolkit / Wizard

- The wizard modal has 4 screens. The first series of questions requests the user's first and last name, email address, and password creation.
- 2 The password will have up to four requirements, in addition to a strength meter. The user can choose to view or hide the password they are typing in.
- Clicking next will submit the form if all fields are confirmed.
- Clicking the X will close the modal and cancel the request. Clicking anywhere off of the modal will NOT close it. The user must click on the X.
- The second view presents additional questions about the user / organization.
- Clicking the Back button will go to the previous screen.
- 7 The final screen asks the user to select prevention topics they are interested in. On hover, an explanation of that topic is displayed.
- A confirmation screen with instructions is displayed once the wizard is completed. Suggested content is presented to the user to click-through.




- 1 When signed in, the utility bar features "My Account."
- The sidebar has a link for users to quickly get back to their toolkit, a list of linked tags, a Fun Fact with an optional CTA, and a campaign ad that links to an external page.
- After user completes the form and clicks "Add to Toolkit" the page will change over to a confirmation message with a link for the user to go view it in their tell.

Notes: Individual Resource (from Prevention Topics)


- The specific Prevention Topic will be designated in the page title header. On click, the user can go to all the resources for that particular topic.






Notes: My Account

- 1 The My Account page displays the user's photo that will trigger an edit/upload modal when the user clicks "EDIT."
- Welcome text with the user's first name, and a button to go to their toolkit.
- 3 All user's information is editable in place, except the password, which must be confirmed by clicking the "Confirm New Password" button.
- The progress module indicates the user's progress toward completion. As users view documents in any Action Group, it counts toward their progress.
- The personalization panel asks a random question to gain new insights about the user.
- The user can skip the question, or click on "NEXT" once they ve selected an answer. Clicking on Show All will reveal an expandable module, below, with all the past questions they've answered. This will give them the ability to change past answers. (See the next page).



- Clicking on edit will allow the user to remove individual resources from the grid. If empty, it will display copy to prompt the user to add content.
- Clicking on "More From the Report" will take the user
- Prevention is a checklist featuring the heading of each item that links to the resource. As the items are viewed, the checkmark next to them gets checked off automatically. Clicking on edit will allow the user to remove unchecked resources from the list. If empty, it
- The All Prevention Topics link takes the user to the Prevention Topics landing page.
- Trainings is a list of seminars / webinars that are available with a title, dater/time, and location. Clicking on edit will allow the user to remove items from the list. If empty, it will display copy to prompt the user to add content.
- The All Trainings link takes the user to the Trainings landing page.
- Get Connected is a grid of blog posts or events. Clicking on edit will allow the user to remove items from the grid. If empty, it will display copy to prompt the user to add content.
- The All Community link takes the user to the Join the




